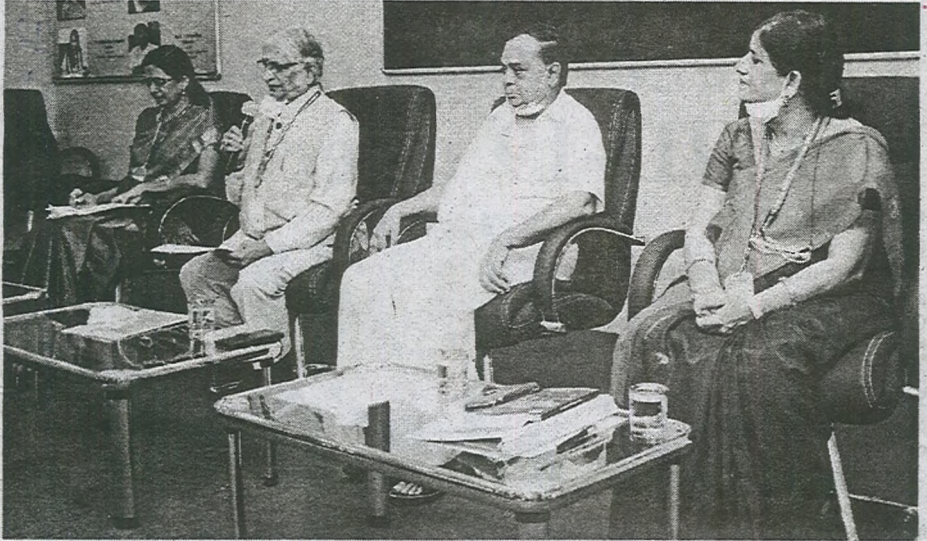

Avinashilingam Institute scores A++ in NAAC audit

The Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women (Deemed to be University) has announced during a press meet held on Monday that the institution has been reaccredited in the 4th cycle by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with A++ Grade and the CGPA of 3.65/4.0, which is one of the highest CGPA in A++ Grade secured among the Indian Universities.

The press meet was jointly addressed by Prof. S P Thyagarajan, Vice-chancellor Dr Bharathi Hari Shankar, Chancellor, Managing Trustee

Dr TSK Meenakshi Sundaram and Registrar Dr S Kausalya. The announcement of the results was made by NAAC on February 22.

The NAAC Peer Team, which visited the Deemed University between February 14 and February 16 had seven experts from different parts of India, along with an Observer from NAAC. The NAAC Peer Team visited all the 36 departments in seven schools situated in the Main Campus and the Satellite Campus. They also visited 12 centres of the institute and various facilities on campus including centralised research facilities, student facilities like hostels, sports, laboratories,

Innovation and Incubation Centre, AVINUTY-EXPO.

They held discussions with the Vice-Chancellor, Dean -Academic, Dean- Research & Consultancy, Dean-Student Affairs, Coordinator of Internal Quality Assessment Cell, Registrar, Finance Officer, Controller of Examinations, e-Resource Centre head and Librarian during their presentations and visit. They also interacted with the Managing Trustee, Board of Trustee members, Chancellor and the members of Board of Management for understanding the governance and leadership structure along with the VISION-2040 of this premier Women's University.
