Anti-ragging meeting held in city

Collector K Rajamani asked all the colleges across the district to make sure they form an anti-ragging committee to address the students' grievances related to ragging. In a meeting convened in the collectorate on Saturday, the collector instructed the college managements to install complaint boxes at the premises. Deputy Commissioner (Law and Order) L Balaji Saravanan, District Revenue Officer Ramadurai Murugan, Deputy Director (Collegiate Education) Ponmuthu Ramalingam and DRDA project director Ruban Sankar Raja were also present in the meeting. Collector Rajamani said no student should be victimised through ragging and asked the college managements to follow the rules under Anti-Ragging act to prevent any mishaps. The newly admitted students must be made aware of anti-ragging toll-free complaint number 1800-180-5522, and the website antiragging.com. The principals were stressed to act on the ragging complaints whenever they receive from the students. The police department would investigate ragging related cases.
