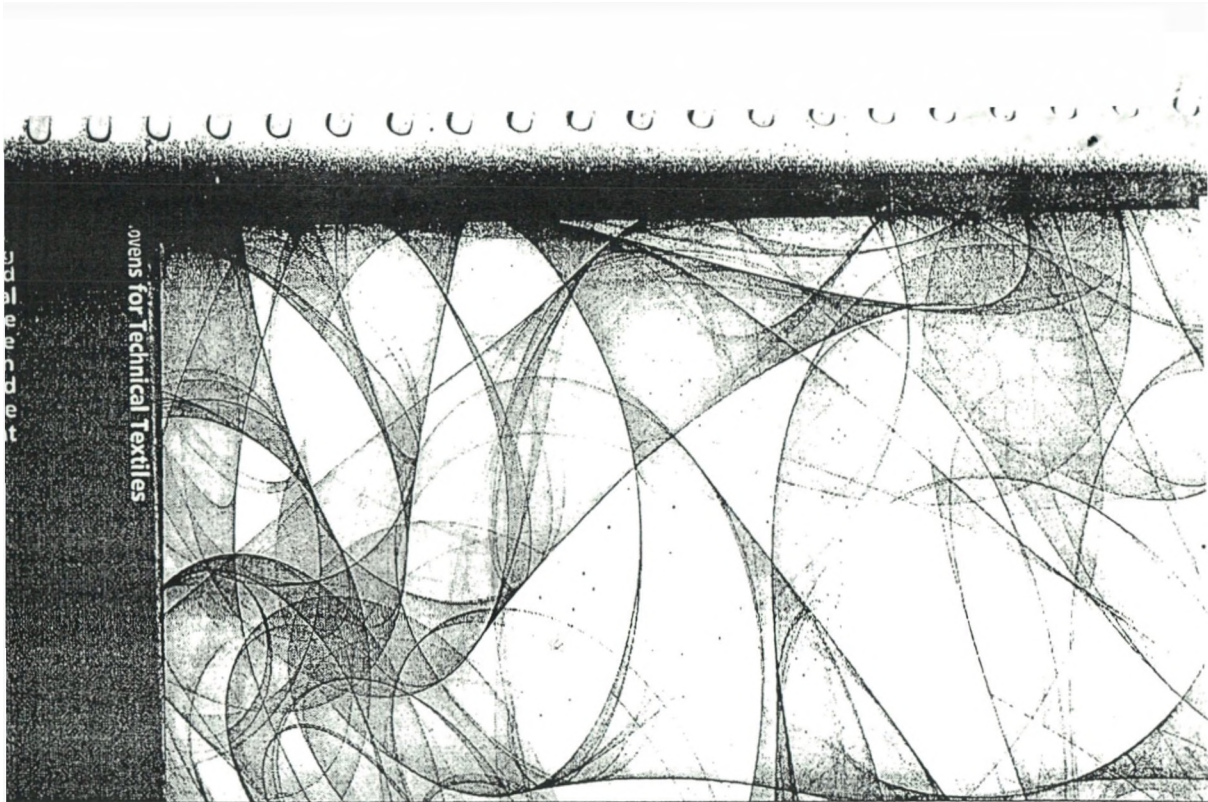
Meenambika P:
